



#### 97% of climate scientists agree:


- Global warming is real

- Human activity is causing almost all the increase.




#### Congressional Consensus on Global Warming

- 2020: ONE




# The Biggest Driver Is Fossil Fuels

The IPCC\* reports we have **10 years** to cut global emissions **by 50%**.







The Energy Innovation AND Carbon Dividend Act

#### How it Works



Charge a fee on fossil fuels at the source

(mine, well, or port)

Return 100% of net revenue to households as a dividend






